Admission:

Education level – usually a bachelors or masters degree, depending on the study for which you are applying; vocational and professional qualifications can also count.

Work experience – you may be expected to have a minimum amount of relevant working experience.

English proficiency – If English is not your native language, you will be asked to demonstrate a particular level of English proficiency.

Syllabus:

Five core modules, three specialisations or elective modules and culminate in a choice of dissertation or consultancy projects for a total of 180 credit points. The first module takes ten weeks and each subsequent module lasts eight weeks. Students start with an orientation of the online classroom. If you do not have a first degree or professional qualifications you will need to demonstrate significant management or business leadership experience (normally 8 years). We will also consider an academic recommendation based on interview Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) or School equivalent:

The Bradford Test. If English is not your first language, we may need evidence of your proficiency in English through a recognised test (IELTS, TOEFL or PTE-A). You will be required to achieve a minimum score of:

- IELTS: 6.5 overall, with no sub-test less than 5.5; or Internet-based TOEFL:
- For EU, non-UK applicants: 94 overall, with minimum scores of: Listening 17, Reading 18, Speaking 20, Writing – 17 - For International, non-UK/EU, applicants (UKBA requirement): 94 overall, with minimum scores of:
Listening – 21, Reading – 22, Speaking – 23, Writing – 21; or - PTE-A (Pearson Test of English Academic): 60 overall, with no sub-test less than 51

Admission:

including but not limited to successful completion of the Graduate Management Admissions Test (GMAT) and a total of at least 950 points for the MBA or 1000 points for the MSA based on the formula: 200 times the cumulative GPA (4.0 system) plus the GMAT score; or at least 1000 points for the MBA or 1050 for the MSA based on the formula: 200 times upper division GPA (4.0 system) plus the GMAT score. Point totals for international students are 50 points greater.

Students processing a degree or diploma from an institution which does not use English as the language of instruction are required to take the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL).

A minimum score of 20 on each section and a minimum total score of 80 for the Internet based exam, or a minimum score of 550 on the paper based exam, or a minimum score of 213 on the computer based exam is required.

A maximum of 9 semester hours (s.h.) of MBA or MSA requirements may be transferred from another AACSB accredited graduate business program or an equivalent international graduate business program with the approval of the director of graduate programs and the dean of the Graduate School. below 23.

- A good degree (or GPA equivalent) or relevant postgraduate/post-experience qualification from a recognised institution, or a professional qualification from an approved and recognised body which is equivalent to a degree;
- Two written references (normally one academic).

Alternatively it is possible to enter the MBA programme without a degree on the basis of a minimum of seven years' relevant managerial or professional experience.

If your first or main language is not English, you must show the university that your level of English is good enough to study at MBA level.

In addition to the standard entry qualifications, you must have one of the following, or equivalent:

- British Council IELTS: normally 6.5 and a minimum of 6.0 in reading and writing;
- TOEFL score of 575 paper-based (233 computer-based or 90 internet-based) or above.

We can advise you on other acceptable alternatives.

If you need to improve your English language skills to meet the entry requirements of the MBA, you can join our pre-sessional courses including a Summer Programme at the university's International Centre. Please ask us for advice.

We welcome applications from candidates with a GMAT score. We do not routinely ask for GMAT scores, but we reserve the right to ask candidates to support their application with a GMAT.
